




Purpose:

Daily Feeding Directions:

All Horses: Offer at least 1.5% of body weight in quality forage. Adjust the following feeding rates up and down based on desired body condition.

Split the following into two to three feedings per day:

Maintenance: Feed 0.75 per 100 lb of body weight. *Light Exercise:* Feed 0.75 lb. per 100 lb of body weight. *Medium Exercise:* Feed 1.00 lb. per 100 lb of body weight.

Heavy Exercise: Feed 1.25 lb. per 100 lb of body weight. *When Used As Forage Substitute:* Feed 1.5-2% of body weight

Important Feeding Information:

- Transition horses onto this feed gradually over 14 days.
- Increase or decrease daily feed to obtain the desired growth, weight gain or body condition.
- Offer clean fresh water and plain white salt at all times.
- Weigh feed and divide feed into two or three separate feedings for best results and safety.
- Store in cool dry area away from rodents, insects and moisture.
- Do not use feed that appears old, molded, or has an unusual odor.
- DO NOT FEED TO SHEEP
